PAYMENT

At Stratosphere Performing Arts, we aim to make fee payments as smooth and straightforward as possible. Here's everything you need to know:

Fees & Invoices: Our fees are billed on a term basis, four times a year. Invoices will be emailed to you one week before each term begins, and payment is due within 14 days. To keep everything running smoothly, please note that a 10% **late fee will apply to invoices not settled within this period.**

Discontinuation Notice: If you decide to discontinue lessons, please provide a 2-week **notice period.** Send your written notice via email to Miss Hayley, and the 2-week notice will start from the date we receive your email.

Payment Options:

- **Cash:** Place cash in an envelope with your child's name and a copy of the invoice inside.
- **Bank Transfer:** Transfer funds to the account listed on your invoice, using your surname and invoice number as the reference. This helps us match payments to the correct account.

UNIFORM

Wearing the correct uniform to dance class at Stratosphere Performing Arts is important for several key reasons:

1. **Respect for the Studio:** Uniforms reflect a commitment to the studio and its values, showing that students take their training seriously.
2. **Consistency in Dance Style:** Uniforms help maintain a cohesive look that aligns with the style of dance being taught, which is especially important for creating a professional appearance in class.
3. **Safety:** Proper uniforms are designed with safety in mind. They ensure that clothing is appropriate for the movements and exercises performed, reducing the risk of injuries.
4. **Class Requirements:** While most classes allow for a variety of uniform pieces, ballet classes specifically require a leotard to ensure proper alignment and technique.

Uniforms can be conveniently purchased through our studio website, ensuring that every student is equipped and ready for class.

FOOTWEAR

Wearing the correct footwear in dance class is essential for several reasons:

1. **Injury Prevention:** Proper shoes provide support and cushioning, reducing the risk of strains and injuries.
2. **Enhanced Performance:** Dance-specific shoes are designed to improve performance, like tap shoes for sound and ballet shoes for alignment.
3. **Classroom Etiquette:** Wearing appropriate shoes shows respect for the class and instructor.
4. **Floor Protection:** Proper shoes prevent damage to studio floors and maintain their quality.

In essence, correct footwear supports safety, performance, and technique, and helps create a professional and comfortable dance environment.

Footwear requirements are as follows:

- **Ballet:** leather split-sole ballet shoes
- **Tap:** Tan tap shoes
- **Jazz:** Tan split sole jazz shoes
- **Lyrical/Contemporary:** Bare feet, half soles or foot thongs
- **Acrobatics:** Tan jazz shoes
- **Hip Hop:** Clean sneakers
- **Cheerleading:** White sneakers
- **Heels:** Black stiletto-heeled boots
